

LETTER OF APPOINTMENT ARRIVES AT BATTALION ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

On May 1, 1962, Commander James M. Hill, Jr., CEC, USN, Commanding Officer of MCB-FOUR, was promoted to his present rank. Commander Hill took command of MCB-FOUR while it was on deployment in Rota, Spain, in 1961.

Upon graduation from the U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis, Md., in 1946, Commander Hill was commissioned a line officer, and served his first tour of duty as the gunnery officer aboard the USS RODMAN (DMS-21). In 1948 he entered Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute to

work on his master's degree in civil engineering. While attending RPI he was redesignated a civil engineer corps officer. After graduation Cdr. Hill was transferred to the Naval Air Station, Jacksonville, Fla., to serve as Assistant Resident Officer in charge of Construction.

While assigned to Commander, Service Force, Pacific Fleet, and the Director, Pacific Division, BuDocks, located in Hawaii, his primary concern was with logistics for construction battalions. In 1955, he was transferred to the District Public (Cont'd on pg 4 col 1)

THE GODD WORD

Several people have expressed concern over the Supreme Court decision which outlawed the saying of a prayer at the beginning of class in public schools. If you will study the Supreme Court case, actually all that was ruled unconstitutional was a New York law which listed the prayer or prayers which could be used in New York public school classrooms. The interpretation given to the decision went further to say that henceforth no prayers of any sort could be said.

It shows wisdom on the part of the Supreme Court when it turned thumbs down on a state law which would dare place a limit on what words could be said to God. I doubt that God would want state legislators to censor communications before they reached Him. Also, if the same old prayers are read every morning it becomes an insult to the intelligence and originality of both God and man. There are several theories about canned prayers, but I know of few churches which approve of state legislators writing an official state prayer book.

On the other hand, if prayer is completely ruled out of order in our public school classrooms, we do have something to start worrying about. While Jewish and Protestant people would perhaps object to a public prayer addressed to "Holy Mother," there would probably be even more objections if prayers of any type were completely eliminated.

Stand back for a great big blast from churches this weekend. I wish churchmen had all the facts about the Supreme Court decision before they start shooting; but there seems to already be enough provocation. We can expect to see those nine men in black robes duck behind the bench starting Monday.
