Requesting Narrative Accounts of the Pentagon Attack

The Naval Historical Center and Naval Reserve Navy Combat Documentation Detachment 206 are gathering information concerning the attack on Navy spaces in the Pentagon on 11 September 2001. This information will form the basis of subsequent studies on the Navy's preparation for the emergency and its response to it. The recollections of those involved in the event are especially relevant and important to this effort. Information on preliminary warnings of the attack, the plane crash, search and rescue effort, extent of damage to offices and passageways, medical and other care of personnel, and related subjects are welcome.

We ask that Navy civilian and military personnel who can provide eye-witness, first-hand descriptions of the attack and its aftermath, e-mail their narrative accounts to the Naval Historical Center's Operational Archives for permanent retention as part of the collection documenting the attack.

Respondents should describe where they were and what they saw, heard, and experienced and include name, office, phone number, and email address. Selected individuals may be contacted by Naval Historical Center or Detachment 206 personnel as candidates for taped oral history interviews.
